One of the oldest universities in India, Panjab University (PU) established in Lahore in 1882, has a long tradition of pursuing excellence in teaching and research in science and technology, humanities, social sciences, performing arts, and sports. Panjab University has ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements (ARIIA) amongst Indian Universities declared by Ministry of Education, Govt. of India in 2020. - The theme should be the main focus of the poster.
- Name and class of study of the participant along with College/ University name must be clearly mentioned on the sheet.
